## Autism Bedfordshire



**Loads of Autistic Fun (LOAF)** – Support and activity group for children aged 0-12 with autism, their parents and siblings. Held fortnightly on Saturday mornings in term time at Lady Zia Wernher School.

**Wanted Fun** – Social club for young people aged 10-17 with Asperger Syndrome. Held every fortnight on Thursday evenings in term time at Families United Network, Britannia Estate, Leagrave Road, Luton.

**Summer Activity Schemes** – Schemes are held for children and young people of different ages (3-17) with autism.
